This test looks at the skills that students need in order to read.
September 11 – 22, 2017	Virginia Kindergarten Readiness Program (VKRP)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All Kindergarten students take this assessment to determine their readiness in mathematics.
September 25 – October 20, 2017	Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening (PALS) for Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All Kindergarten students take this test to look at the skills needed to read.
October 2 – 13, 2017	First Grading Period Benchmark Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students enrolled in grades 2 – 5 take an end-of-nine weeks test in Reading and Mathematics based on what they have been taught.
December 4 – 15, 2017	Second Grading Period Benchmark Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students enrolled in grades 2 – 5 take an end-of-nine weeks test in Reading and Mathematics based on what they have been taught.
January 2 – 26, 2018	Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening (PALS) for grades K – 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students in grades K & 1, and students in grades 2 & 3 who receive additional reading help take this test. This test looks at mid-year progress on students' reading skills.
February 12 – 23, 2018	Cognitive Abilities Test (CoGAT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All grade 2 students take this test looking for potential strengths in student learning.
February 19 – March 2, 2018	Third Grading Period Benchmark Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students enrolled in grades 2 – 5 take an end-of-nine weeks test in Reading and Mathematics based on what they have been taught.
February 28, 2018	5th grade Alternative Writing Assessment: Multiple-Choice Component	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All 5th grade students are required by the Department of Education to take an alternative writing test to measure their writing skills. This is a substitute for the former Grade 5 Writing SOL test.
March 1, 2018	5th grade Alternative Writing Assessment: Short-Paper Component	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All 5th grade students are required by the Department of Education to take an alternative writing test to measure their writing skills. This is a substitute for the former Grade 5 Writing SOL test.
April 2 – 6, 2018	3rd & 5th Grade Alternative Assessments for Science & History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All 3rd and 5th grade students are required by the Department of Education to take an alternative science and history test to measure their content skills. These are substitutes for the former Grade 3 Science, Grade 3 History, and Grade 5 US History SOL tests.
